Dear Parents and Carers,

**Re: Misuse of Bumblebees Nursery Car Park**

I hope this letter finds you well. I am reaching out to address an important concern regarding the safety and parking arrangements at Bumblebees Nursery.

Recently, we have observed an increase in speeding and use of this car park for drop-offs and pick-ups. This has raised serious safety concerns for everyone, particularly for parents and carers with young children, including toddlers and babies, who use this space. It has also come to our attention that some parents and carers are inadvertently putting our children in harm's way by parking too close to the school entrance or failing to slow down upon entry to the car park. There have been several reports of children nearly being struck by vehicles, which is an alarming situation we must avoid. To keep our children safe, we therefore kindly ask you to refrain from parking on the double yellow lines near Bumblebees and the school entrance. These markings are in place for everyone's safety and we want to be proactive in preventing accidents, not waiting for an unfortunate incident to occur.

In addition, we kindly ask that you avoid using the Bumblebees Nursery car park for school-related drop-offs and pick-ups. By doing so, we can ensure a safer, more accessible environment for our pupils walking into school, keep the younger children safe whilst being dropped off or collected from nursery and maintain good relations with our local community.

While we recognise that parking is limited and we are actively seeking solutions, it is vital that we all work together to ensure the safety of our community. By being considerate and vigilant, we can help to protect our children and the most vulnerable children (babies and toddlers) in our community.

I look forward to seeing positive changes as a result of our collective efforts. Thank you for your understanding and usual cooperation in this matter.
