Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the final half term for this academic year. We hope that you had a relaxing half term break.

Medical Glove Boxes needed

As part of our Design Technology scheme of learning this term, the children will be making a toy car. For this project, we require boxes. The ideal type required is the box used for medical gloves. This is approximately 22cm long by 12cm wide by 6cm deep. If you have access to these, we would be most grateful if you could collect them and send them into school.

Hats

As the weather is now sunnier, please ensure that your child has a hat or cap in school for playtimes and PE sessions. Sunscreen can be applied before school and/or children can bring their own. Children are not permitted to share other children's sunscreen.

English

This week, we will:



- Explore comprehension question types, question words and how to answer comprehension questions fully.
- Complete a short-written answer reading comprehension. (30 minutes)
- Complete a longer written answer reading comprehension (45 minutes).

Maths

This week, we will:

- Read analogue clocks for o'clock, half past, quarter past and half past.
- Begin to tell the time to 5 minutes, beginning with times past the hour.

Reading

Learning to read is essential to allow children to read to learn across the curriculum. In addition to their school reading, it is very important that every child endeavours to read each day at home. This could be independently, to an adult, in unison with an adult or to a younger sibling. A parent reading to a child is also a fantastic tool for improving children's reading, vocabulary and understanding of sentence structure and syntax.

Science

This week, we will complete an assessment about materials and their everyday uses.

History

This week, we will complete our History topic 'Communication through the ages'. We will be sequencing communication types through history on a timeline and labelling with dates and the names of significant figures involved in their invention.

Art

This week, we will use clay and a clay tile to create our flower tile design.

Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) - online times-tables practice tool

Please continue to support your child to access Times Tables Rock Stars little and often at home. If you have any questions, please ask.

Homework

Homework consists of weekly tasks reflecting and consolidating the class teaching from the week.



Homework is set on a Friday and should be returned by the following Thursday. Children should work for half an hour and complete as much as possible. Homework is designed as a consolidation and demonstration of knowledge and understanding and should not be onerous. A spelling test of 10 words containing the phonics spelling pattern learnt on the previous week will take place each Friday. Scores will be recorded in the Home-school diary.

General information

- P.E. kits, reading books and home-school diaries will be needed in school every day. PE kits can be left on their peg.
- As always, it is important to label all of your child's belongings with your child's name.
- Please ensure your child has a labelled drink bottle for WATER.
