Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to inform you about our Foundation and Key Stage One Sports day which is set to run on Monday 15<sup>th</sup> June at 1.30 pm.

For your information, we run our Sports Day with a focus on teamwork throughout all the events. This means that Foundation children will work alongside Year One and Year Two children. The children will work in seven different groups, with representatives from all the teams in each one. These groups will rotate around the field to complete each of the seven activities.

**Your child/children will be working in Group \_\_\_\_\_.** Please keep this information with you, as it will help you to know where to go and watch your child at their first activity.

You are more than welcome to walk around the outside of the track in order to follow your child's progress and give their team encouragement. However, for safeguarding reasons, please stay behind our respect barriers at all times.

If you have two children within the Key Stage, they will work in the same group so that you can follow their progress together. After each group has completed all seven activities, the children will come back and sit in their classes. They will then be given the scores so far, before competing in the class running races.

**ACTIVITIES THE CHILDREN WILL COMPLETE ARE:**

Football skills  
Egg and spoon race  
Running baton relay  
Steal the treasure  
Scooter race  
Quoit balance  
Throwing challenge

**ORDER OF THE RUNNING RACES:- For the children to run in the lanes there will be 4 races per class, 2 girls and 2 boys races.**

Red Bear Girls, Red Bear Boys, Blue Bear Girls, Blue Bear Boys, 1CP Girls, 1CP Boys, 1DM Girls, 1DM Boys, 2H Girls, 2H Boys, 2W Girls, 2W Boys.

When the running races have finished, we will add up the total score and award the winning team with the Sports Day Cup.

At the end of the afternoon, your child will be taken back to their classroom. We do understand that it is an exciting day, but we would appreciate it if you did not encourage your child to come over and see you. It can be very busy and we need to know that all children are with us at all times. They will stay in their P.E kits and will be dismissed through their normal exits at the close of school day - 3.20 pm. Please ensure that your child has the correct P.E kit in school on this day, along with their coloured t-shirt. Please also remember to send your child with a hat and a bottle of water. We look forward to seeing you there!
