English

We will continue with the book 'This is how we do it'. This is a non-fiction text which looks at the lives of seven children from around the world. The children will create a book all about themselves, including who they live with, who they play with, what they like to eat and school life.

Maths

This week, we will be focusing on:

- 3D shape names.

Polite reminders

Suncream - Any suncream brought in to school should be cream and not aerosol to avoid accidents. Please apply suncream at home in the morning, where possible.

We do not permit Foundation and Key Stage One children to bring any other bags to school as this is unnecessary and we do not have space to store such items.’
