Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Foundation Stage and Key Stage One Tickets for Christmas Nativity

We hope many of you will be able to join us at our Christmas Nativity. Tickets have to be limited to **two** per family. We expect that separated parents should liaise and communicate directly with each other in relation to ordering tickets for performances. These are allocated per family and not per parent and we expect parents to share these equally. **Everybody who attends needs a ticket to gain entry regardless of age due to fire regulations (this includes babies)**. If you arrive without your ticket, you will be asked to wait until the end of the queue.

Tickets will be issued as soon as the forms are returned to us. If there are any spare tickets available, a text message will be sent on **Wednesday 11th December 2024** offering one extra ticket per family on a first come, first served basis. If you are able to come to either performance, could you indicate this on the form. If we run out of tickets for one performance, we can, therefore, issue you with tickets for the other.

Key Stage Two children will watch the Key Stage One dress rehearsal. Children from our neighbouring pre-school providers have also been invited to the dress rehearsal with their key workers.

Please ensure that your child attends the evening event in order to make it a success. If your child cannot attend, please inform Mrs Hamilton in writing.

We look forward to seeing many of you at the performances where we will be collecting for the RNLI at the end of each performance. The children have voted to support this charity this year. **You are welcome to take photos and videos during the performances, but these must be kept for private viewing and cannot be published on Facebook or any other social networking site.** Pushchairs cannot be taken into the hall as there is not enough room to accommodate them. They can be left in the entrance corridor.
