Dear Parents and Carers,

As your child begins their journey through Key Stage Two, we are delighted to share with you the enriching opportunities they will have to participate in a variety of educational visits and experiences. These trips are designed to support both their academic learning and personal development, helping them to grow in confidence, curiosity, and independence.

Below is an overview of the planned visits across Years Three to Six. Please note that some visits may change according to the curriculum and the **costs listed are based on previous years and are likely to change.**

Year Three

- **Swimming Lessons:** A vital part of the PE curriculum, these sessions help children develop water confidence and essential life skills. The school will fund the cost of the swimming lessons and the majority of the coach costs. However, we do ask for a parental contribution for the coach.
Contribution towards coach costs: £20
- **Central Park Visit:** A local trip that supports learning in PE (orienteeing) geography and PSHE, with opportunities for outdoor exploration and teamwork.
Cost: £7

Year Four

- **Buckland Abbey:** A historical site visit that enhances understanding of Tudor history and art.
Cost: £11
- **Kents Cavern:** A fascinating trip into prehistoric Britain, supporting learning in history and science.
Cost: £15
- **Adventure Race Residential (1 night):** A fantastic opportunity for children to build resilience, teamwork, and independence.
Cost: £90

Year Five

- **Mountbatten Activities Week:** A week of outdoor and water-based activities that promote leadership, cooperation, and physical development.
Cost: £250



Year Six

- **Residential Trip:** A memorable experience that offers a mix of adventure, reflection, teamwork and celebration as well as to experience a wide range of activities.

Cost: £400

We firmly believe that school trips and visits are a vital part of a child's education. They provide real-world contexts for learning, foster social skills, and create lasting memories. These experiences often ignite passions and interests that stay with children for life.
