Numeracy

This week we are focusing on measure. We will be comparing size, weight and capacity. At home you could encourage your child to compare the weight of two objects, saying which is the heaviest or lightest. Other areas:

- Talking about Harvest with Miss Freeman.
- PE - aiming beanbags into hoops and at targets, working on throwing in a controlled way.
- Talking about our feelings and how we know how other people are feeling.
- Listening to songs and talking about how they make us feel and what they make us think of
- Moving to music.
- Completing an assault course and discussing how exercise makes our bodies feel eg: our heart rate, feeling sweaty etc.

Reminders:

- Please make sure all uniform, coats and book bags are named, including shoes.
- The children can bring in their own fresh fruit or vegetable snack if they want. They can have this in addition to the snack provided in school. Please do not include anything that isn't fruit or veg eg: cheese, dips or yoghurt coated fruit bits.
